The coat of arms:

At this stage we have not been able to locate a coat of arms in colour. This one came from the "Nederland's Patriciaat" booklet:

It is a silver waxing moon on blue background above three green stemmed red roses on a silver background.

At this stage the family tree starts with Lammert Woltersz from Helmond around 1550. Helmond is located some 15k ENE from Eindhoven in Noord Brabant, Netherlands. The next one is Woouter Lambertsz from Leeuwarden who's son was called Take Woutersz de Vries (? Meaning from Friesland?). He did get married with Meynngen Jacobs in Leiden in 1606. From here onwards the family resides in and around Amsterdam.

1. Lammert Woltrsz probably born around 1550 in or near Helmond. Towards the end of 1582 he become a citizen of Leeuwarden in Friesland

2.1. Wouter Lambertsz de Vries born in Leeuwarden. He was a merchant, first in Leiden, then in Amsterdam. He married Meynngen Jacobs in Leiden 30/09/1606. She was the daughter of Jacob Jacobs & Ermpge Jans.

They had probably four children:

3.2.1.1. Jacob Woutersz de Vries was born in Leiden about 1607. Aged about 24, he married the 20 year old Christina van Haemel Abrahamsdr in Amsterdam 21/05/1634 She was born in Amsterdam around 1611.

3.2.1.2. Abraham Woutersz de Vries born in Leiden. He married Jannecke de Rijcker. He died in Amsterdam 23/08/1667.

3.2.1.4. Take Woutersz de Vries We don't know with who he married.

4.3.2.1.4.2. Wouter Takesz de Vries born around 1650. He came from IJlst. Aged about 39 he married the 37 year old Judith van Eijck in Amsterdam 17/07/1689. Judith was born in Amsterdam around 1652, the daughter of Gerrit Hendriksz van Eijck and Mijnsje van Veen Jansdr who was a widow of Matheus Hendriksz.

A year after their wedding, Wouter became an Amsterdam citizen 31/10/1690.
Wouter was a merchant.

Aged about 59, Judith was buried in Amsterdam 15/04/1711, 17 years later, aged 78, Wouter died in Buiksloot 10/04/1728.

5.4.3.2.1.4.2.1. Debora born in Amsterdam on 15/01/1697. Aged 22 she married the 27 year old Huijbert van Beusekom in Amsterdam 26/02/1719. [Huijbert's sister, Maria had married Debora's brother, (**5.4.3.2.1.4.2.1. Gerrit**) five years earlier.] Huijbert was born in Amsterdam around 1692, the son of Anthony av Beusekom & Immelia van Woensel.

Debora died aged 33 in Amsterdam 24/01/1730. 26 Years later, Huijbert died in Amsterdam 16/03/1756.

5.4.3.2.1.4.2.1. Gerrit de Vries born in Amsterdam on 01/03/1691. Aged 23 he married the 26 year old Maria van Beusekom in Amsterdam 02/12/1714, [who's brother was to marry Gerrit's sister five years later (**5.4.3.2.1.4.2.1. Debora**)]. Maria was born in Amsterdam on 09/03/1688, the daughter of Anthony av Beusekom & Immelia van Woensel.

Gerrit was a merchant

Maria died, aged 41, in Amsterdam 02/05/1739. Gerrit, aged 63, died 15 years later in Amsterdam 03/04/1754.

6.5.4.3.2.1.4.2.1.1. Immelia born in Amsterdam 27/09/1716. Aged 19 she married the 27 year old Gerrit Reessen in Amsterdam 10/05/1735. Gerrit was born in Amsterdam around 1708, the son of Isaac Reessen and Gesina ten Cate. Aged 38, he was buried in Amsterdam 18/02/1746.

11 Years later, aged 40, Immelia married a second time, this time with the 45 year old Martin Christiaan Hinke in Amsterdam 14/06/1757. Martin was born around 1712, the son of Christiaan Hinke and Maria Elisabet Bolinius. He was the widower of Catrina Witman.

6.5.4.3.2.1.4.2.1.3. Gerrit born in Amsterdam on 06/10/1720. Aged 25 he married the 22 year old Anna Theodora van Lankeren in Amsterdam 21/12/1745. Anna was baptised in Hulst 15/09/1723, the daughter of Laurens van Lankeren and Anna Verbeek.

Gerrit was a merchant.

Anna was buried in Amsterdam 11/11/1762, aged 39. Five years later Gerrit died, aged 46, in Amsterdam 01/08/1767.

Maria died, aged 33, in Amsterdam 25/11/1757.

6.5.4.3.2.1.4.2.1.2. Abraham de Vries born in Amsterdam on 03/11/1718. Aged 25 he married the 22 year old Christina Kup in Amsterdam on 10/09/1743. Christina was born in Amsterdam 25/05/1721, the daughter of Willem Kup and Elisabeth van Voorst.

He was a merchant

Aged 47, he died in Amsterdam 11/03/1765. 43 Years later, Chritina died in Amsterdam 05/02/1808, aged 87.

Bernardus was born in Amsterdam on 31/08/1742, the son of Jeronimo de Bosch and Catharina van der Heijden.

Aged 73, Jeronimo died in Amsterdam on 30/07/1816. 24 Years later aged 90, Christina died in Amsterdam on 20/05/1840.

7.6.5.4.3.2.1.4.2.1.2.1. Gerrit de Vries born in Amsterdam on 21/08/1744. Aged 24 he married the 24 year old Catharina de Bosch in Amsterdam on 16/04/1769. One year later her older brother Bernardus' married Gerrit's younger sister Christina.

Catharina was born in Amsterdam on 22/02/1745, the daughter of Jeronimo de Bosch and Catharina van der Heijden.

Gerrit was a merchant and head of the local pumping-station.

Catharina died, aged 55, she died in Amsterdam 05/02/1801. Nine years later, Gerrit died in Amsterdam on 05/12/1810 (St Nicolas day).

Abraham was a Minister of the "Doopsgezinde Church" and council Librarian in Haarlem (painting to the right)

Abraham died in Haarlem on 03/11/1862, aged 89. Hillegonda died three years later in Haarlem 25/03/1866, aged 75.

She was born in Amsterdam 25/02/1780, the daughter of Johannes Marinus Verhoesen and Dina Josina van Deventer. Jeronimo was a man of letters and translated the Treaty of Grotius in Dutch. Maria died in Amsterdam 02/09/1833, aged 53. Jeronimo died 20 years later, aged 77, in Amsterdam 01/06/1853.

Abraham married a second time, aged 30, in Barneveld 12/10/1877 with the 22 year old Maria Hendrika Schut. She was born in Ouder-Amstel 20/02/1850, the daughter of Willem Schut and Elisabeth Moeriaans.

Abraham was Member of the Court in Batavia, in the Department of Colonies, Knight of the Nederlands Leeuw.

He worked with the Technical Services at Rooy and Co in Yogyakarta.

Aged 65, Antonia died in the Japanese prison camp Batavia, camp Tjideng 21/05/1945, Aged 56, Jacobus died five months later in the Ambarawa, camp 7 08/10/1945
